SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION CHANGES

Grade 2 – Reconciliation & First Communion Grade 6 – Confirmation

This year Sacraments (First Communion and Confirmation) will be taught through St. Gerard Parish on Saturdays much like it was done last year. Gyan Reyes is the instructor. He will be available at the Parish on Saturday, September 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. for you to meet him, hand in your registration forms or to talk with him personally if you have any questions. We sent the registration forms and class dates home so you have all the information needed to register your child for Sacramental preparation. If you choose to register your child either prepare the registration forms and return to Gyan on Saturday or return to the school by September 12, 2019 and we will forward to the parish office.

EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS

All families have received a copy of "2019/2020 Year-at-a-Glance" which indicates holidays, in-service, administration days, and early dismissal days for the school year. These days are printed on the monthly school calendar which your child brings home with the newsletter.

Please mark the dates at home to remind yourself when your child will be dismissed early to ensure they have a ride at 2:25 p.m. Early dismissal days are scheduled to provide time for school personnel to attend Staff Meetings. Teachers/Staff are <u>not</u> available to supervise students after 2:30 p.m. on these days. Students are not permitted to wait unsupervised for their ride – and students not picked up by 2:30 will be sent to the *After School Program* (a service Parents **will be** charged for).

<u>DO NOT</u> INSTRUCT YOUR CHILD TO PHONE TO REMIND, OR ARRANGE RIDES ON EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS. TRANSPORTATION ARRANGEMENTS, ETC. SHOULD BE MADE IN ADVANCE. THE PHONE IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE IS FOR <u>EMERGENCY</u> USE ONLY.

We do our best to keep our families informed of all school events.

It is the parent's responsibility to read <u>all</u> school correspondence in a timely manner to ensure they are informed of important announcements/events. Parents should check backpacks/agenda books <u>daily</u> for notes, newsletters, permission slips, etc. (Ask your child each day if there are any notes sent home from school!) Parents who do not receive a calendar/newsletter each month, should contact the School Office to have another sent home. Thank you!

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATONS!

Many of our families in past years have chosen to celebrate their child's birthday by generously providing the entire class with cake, treats, and beverages.

Unfortunately, the school is unable to allow this practice – mainly due to severe food allergies which may prevent some children from participating in the "party".

(As well, the celebration is a disruption to the day's lessons.)

The teachers have asked that <u>all</u> birthday celebrations be conducted at venues <u>outside</u> of the school. St. Gerard will continue to recognize our students' birthdays by sending greetings to them during morning announcements, as well as granting them a "N.U.T." Day (**No U**niform **T**oday).

SCHOOL FEES

All families are aware of their yearly mandatory school fees, and have been invoiced for such.

Please be aware that all SEPTEMBER fees were due **September 1**st, and should be submitted to the School Office (Activity, Building Improvement, Tuition, School Bus).

If you have not already done so, and in order to keep your account up-to-date, please submit your fees immediately.

(<u>Note</u>: An outstanding *Activity Fee* may hinder your child's participation in Field Trips until fees, which are used to pay for these events, are collected.)

If you have submitted your payments, they will be applied to your account accordingly, and you will receive a receipt.

Reduced Speed Limits in School Zones:

Please remember the reduced speed zone on Talbot Avenue. The reduced speed limit is set at 30 km/hr and in force Monday to Friday from 7:00 – 17:30, in the months of September to June. This has been set out by the City of Winnipeg. You will find signs to indicate the start and end of the reduced speed zone. Please be mindful of this as you drive down Talbot Avenue during the school months. It is for the safety of our children.


THE SCHOOL OFFICE <u>DOES NOT</u> KEEP TRACK OF THE HOURS YOU HAVE VOLUNTEERED.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL ALL YOUR CHILD'S BELONGINGS WITH THEIR NAME (INCLUDING SCHOOL SUPPLIES, GYM/FOOTWEAR, SWEATERS, LUNCH BOX/THERMOS, ETC.). THERE ARE MANY ITEMS COLLECTED IN THE "LOST & FOUND" THAT HAVE NEVER BEEN CLAIMED - AS ITEMS ARE NOT LABELLED. "LOST & FOUND" ITEMS NOT CLAIMED AT THE END OF EACH MONTH ARE DONATED TO A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION. PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO CHECK "LOST & FOUND" FOR ITEMS THEY MAY HAVE MISPLACED.
