2023-2024 REGISTRATION

Registration Packages for the 2023-2024 School Year will be going home with your child mid-February.

The registration packages contain white pages and coloured pages. White pages are information only and are for you to keep.

All coloured pages (with the exception of the grey OPTIONAL School Bus form) must be completed (including signatures), and returned to the school in order to successfully register your child. Registrations missing any coloured forms or fees will be returned to families as "INCOMPLETE". If you have a child of age for Kindergarten, please notify the school ASAP in order to ensure a spot is available.

Those families who will <u>not</u> be returning for the 2023/24 school year should indicate so, on the top page of the Registration Package, sign and return the entire package as requested.

<u>Please note:</u> If you currently use the Before and After School Program, new registration forms for 2023/24 will be sent out with the March invoices. If you anticipate the use of the Before/After School Program for 2023/24, and have not used it before, please see the office for forms.

Any questions regarding the packages can be directed to the School Office.

All returning students should have their registration packages back to school by Friday, February 24, 2023.

Friendly Reminder for Bus Students

Ensure your child is at their stop 5 minutes prior to pick-up time.

If Mrs. Wong cannot answer the phone while driving, please leave a message on her cellphone and she will call you back once she is done with her run.

The School is again reminding all our families to please follow our "road safety" rules to ensure our children are safely dropped off and picked up from school:

- ► The lane is ONE WAY from Foster to Grey streets during morning drop off and afternoon pick up.
- ► We thank our families for following the signage that indicates the area in front of our back lane door is a "No Stopping / No Drop-Off" area. For the safety of our children please park in an open parking spot against the gym wall when dropping off or picking up your child.

(NOTE: the spots against the school wall that are "numbered" are for <u>STAFF ONLY</u>. As there are minimal spots available for our staff's use, please refrain from parking or stopping in these stalls at **ANY TIME**.)

<u>DO NOT STOP OR PARK YOUR VEHICLE ON OUR NEIGHBOUR'S PROPERTY!</u>

- Many of our families are stopping/parking "hugged" up against the garages/fences situated along the school's back_lane. These areas are not school or public property therefore, our families should be respecting the property of the home owner. Let's_practice and encourage_"healthy living lifestyles" with our children by walking the short distance!
- The <u>2 handicapped</u> parking spaces located near the gym entrance are to_be used_by vehicles with designated_handicapped stickers only <u>PLEASE</u>.
- Please <u>do not</u> park in the School Bus Loading Zone on Foster Street (as_indicated on the street signs).

Let's be respectful of each other – as we ask our children to be.

SCHOOL BUS NEWS



The School Bus will not run if the temperature (with wind chill) is -45 or colder. In the event that the bus is cancelled in the morning this cancellation will be in effect for the whole day. Please listen to CJOB for Winnipeg division school bus information. You will be contacted by phone that the bus is not running.

Please have your family waiting at their stop in the morning. They should be dressed appropriate for the weather conditions, as at times, the bus may be running behind schedule due to traffic or weather conditions – and the children may have to wait a few minutes longer for the bus to arrive. If all our passengers are ready and waiting at their stop, this helps keep the bus on schedule.

STUDENT ILLNESS & MEDICATION



As indicated in the Student Handbook, St. Gerard School does not have facilities to accommodate children who are ill. When a student becomes ill, we will call a parent (or Emergency Contact, if necessary) to request that the student be picked up. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT FAMILIES ENSURE ALL PHONE NUMBERS IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE ARE CURRENT. Out of consideration for the health of others, a child who is not well should be kept at home.

Please contact the School Office when your child will not be in attendance at school due to illness, appointments, or other planned/unplanned absences.

The school does not keep pain relief or cough medication on hand to administer to students.

A child who is not well enough to go outside for recess should be kept at home.

Parents should administer any required medication at home, when possible. If a student requires a prescription (or over-the-counter) medication to be administered at school – parents must complete an "Authorization of Prescribed Medication" form (available from the Office); or submit a note to the Office with the medication indicating:

- DATE THE NOTE
- NAME OF CHILD/GRADE
- NAME OF MEDICATION
- DOSAGE OF MEDICATION & TIME TO BE TAKEN, AS WELL AS ANY SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS (I.E. TO BE TAKEN AFTER LUNCH). THE MEDICATION SHOULD BE DELIVERED TO THE SCHOOL IN THE ORIGINAL PHARMACY'S CONTAINER.

WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION is imperative for your child's safety. It is not the school's responsibility to decide when medication should be administered - and therefore specific instructions from the parent must be submitted with the medication. Students should not be presenting medication to the Office with "verbal" instructions from home. For the safety of your child: Please take the time to write out this important information.

For the safety of the entire school – all medication should be kept in the School Office.

<u>Please do not send medication with your child and advise them "... to keep it in their backpack or locker until they need it".</u> This is an extremely unsafe practice and can put the School in a precarious situation should the medication be accessed and ingested by another student.
